With ramps being as steep as 15 degrees (1:4), this creates a manual handling concern when pushing 660 litre and 1100 litre waste bins.

A high risk of musculoskeletal injury and potential deterioration of bins cause damage to tenant's property. This should be a concern for all body corporates and building managers.

Electrodrive has a waste management solution that allows one person to safely tow waste bins with a battery powered tug up steep inclines (up to 14 degrees) with very little effort, while maintaining control of the bin.



Bolt-on tow hitch to suit 660 or 1100 litre bins (one set per bin). Each set includes:





Required for safety purposes, directional lock tabs are fitted to your bin's existing rear swivel castors to enable controlled steering and towing in a straight line.

WARNING

Never tow with four swivel castors. Towing bins with four swivel castors will cause problems with trailing and 'fishtailing'-cutting corners rather than following the unit.

- Fitted between castor plate and base of bin for reliability and safety.
